

## TOWN ADMINISTRATOR REPORT 3-10-25

- Mr. Covey at VTrans has finally approved and issued our 1111 permit for Phase I of the Stormwater Project. I have a copy in writing so there can be no take backs this time.
- I will be working on submitting the Aquatic Nuisance Grant application this week and working on getting this year's Greeter Program detailed out.
- Noel and I found out that we have to manually renew our .gov domain every year, so we have added that to our IT responsibilities list
- Rooted Entertainment would like to host their open mic Listening Room weekly event here at the auditorium on Thursday nights. This is a free event, but he understands that we have cleaning charges to pay so he was thinking about running a fundraiser event to raise money to cover cleaning costs.
- We will have a weekly karate class starting at the end of the month and running every Tuesday for 6 weeks. If it's successful, they would like to talk about more classes on a seasonal basis.
- I'll be meeting with Jane Cadwalader, from the Vt State Archives and Records Administration, to talk about grant funding awards that they have received from the National Historical Publications and Records Commission.
