

TOWN ADMINISTRATOR REPORT 6/2/25

- We have hired a new transfer station attendant, Jon Gillespie, who started on Saturday the 31st. It was an unfortunate day weather wise to start an outside job, but he reported that everything went as well as could be expected. We will still keep the help wanted sign up and search for a second person so that all areas of the transfer station are covered.
- A reminder that the lake will be treated for milfoil on 6/17. Peter and Greg Allen have been assembling and putting up signs around the lake, I've notified the LMPA and we have sent notices out to all lake abutting properties
- I will be attending a virtual hearing concerning the Bridge + Main project funding from ACCD this Thursday morning. I will be there to answer any questions or concerns that the deciding committee may have concerning the Town's role in this project as the financial pass-through.
- I hope to be attending the 2025 Village Meet Up this Thursday in Reading VT, hosted by the Preservation Trust of Vermont. Topics there will include village scale housing and infrastructure, economic development for rural communities and rural revitalization ideas and efforts across the state.
- The deadline for proposals concerning phase II of our stormwater/sidewalk plan closed last Friday. We received three planning proposals; Dubois and King, Pathways, and MSK. Rita and I will set up a time in the near future to review and grade the three proposals before moving forward.
- We have a request from Bill Minard to have a presentation on Loons upstairs in the auditorium on Monday, July 10th at 7pm. Do the SB have any reservations about sharing the building on a meeting night?
- Andrea Day would like to meet with me and a SB member to continue to discuss plans concerning a village wastewater treatment option on 6/6

at 10am. The discussion will center around whether the Town attempt a low flow landing option or a full wastewater treatment facility option.
