

## TOWN ADMINISTRATOR REPORT 6-16-25

- A reminder that the treatment for milfoil in Lake Morey will take place tomorrow morning, folks should stay out of the water until at least 3pm on Wednesday the 18<sup>th</sup>
- I will be out of the office tomorrow to attend the Vermont Local Roads Round Table in Randolph where a number of road related topics will be discussed including erosion and ditching, the Better roads program, hydrologically connected road practices and a number of best practices involved in road maintenance
- I will also be out of the office on Thursday and Friday due to the holiday and a personal day
- The water shutoff repair and maintenance project that took place in front of the common was successful. This shutoff replacement gives us even more control over the zones that need to be shutoff when there is a repair or emergency.
- Rootstock Racing's Endless Mountains Adventure Race will take place next week, from the 24<sup>th</sup> through the 28<sup>th</sup>. There will be small teams of 2-4 people accessing the road around Lake Morey, accessing our class 4 roads and the Town forest on foot. Because of the spread out nature of the overall race (Fairlee is stage 4 of 11 total stages) and the small team sizes, there should be no disruption of traffic along their routes. The SB did approve this back in February or this year, as a reminder.
- The project PR person for the ledge work/interstate closure reached out to me to ask about coordinating a public meeting to get some awareness and have a Q&A session for anyone interested. Right now they are planning an evening meeting on Wednesday the 25<sup>th</sup>, possibly 6pm, either hybrid or fully remote due to the tight timeline. The contractors are scheduled to begin shutting down the interstate on Monday, 7/14, for 35 days.

- Knoblach road has some washout issues from last weeks rain, Mike will address this before week's end.
- The auditorium has been rented out this Saturday for a celebration of life event
