

## TOWN ADMINISTRATOR REPORT 7-7-25

- There is a scam going around on Indeed that lists a help wanted ad for a Town Administrator in Fairlee. When you contact the group that posted the job, they request money in return for reviewing your application. I have received several calls about this and I have reported it to Indeed, if you have a moment to go on and report the job listing as well, that would be helpful.
- We have a quote for upgraded lighting on the bandstand, \$5,335, I am just waiting for the electrician to settle on a final date to get the work done. I am waiting for the library trustees to decide on a lighting style for the parking lot and then I will have a final quote and date of installation on that project.
- I had a company ready to grind the brush at the transfer station, they then informed me that they were moving their business to more demolition based projects and would no longer be grinding material off site. I will track down other companies this week to get this done, as it's been a few years since the last time it happened.
- I've got all the signs and safety devices ordered for the HSIP (highway safety improvement program) grant that was applied for in 2022. I need to reach out to Tad to see what his plans for the delineators were, as they are not clearly marked on the project map. These signs consist of chevrons for sharp corners as well as curved road signs.
- I'm in talks with Evan Eccher from Green Mountain Power to try to get a quote for extending power further into the transfer station so that we can move forward with getting compactors in there. The good news is that there is already phase 3 power running to the transfer station gate.
- The results from the latest ProcellaCOR treatment arrived yesterday: the water test shows less than 1ppm traceable in the lake water that was sampled, which is great news for all the lake users.
