

TOWN ADMINISTRATOR REPORT 12-22-25

- **Architectural Plans Update:** I met with Jeremy Greeley to discuss transition plans for when I leave the office. He brought updated plans for the Vault, the Annex building and a preliminary program for the Library. I gave him Peter's contact info for meeting purposes and the Treasurer's info to forward invoices to. He would like to work with Village Ventures to get some ballpark figures on all the buildings involved, which will be useful for grant application purposes.
- **Fireworks Update:** To date we have received \$3100, though we have several folks pledging to donate a lot more. It sounds like Mark Avery is asking us not to reach out with any more donation requests. I have signed and e-mailed out the contract so that we can reserve our 7/4/26 slot for the show.
- **Water Service Lines Update:** I spoke with John Peckham and Bruce King from the DEC about submitting our drinking water service line inventory this year. While we have the customer side data thanks to the notes from the meter install project, we will still need to come up with the service line side data before 2030. He explained that he can help us apply for a forgivable loan program when the time comes to provide proof that our system has no lead lines.
- **Highway Budget Update:** Peter, Miranda, Jess and I had a productive meeting with Jonathan Blake concerning the budget numbers for 2026 Highway. Jess was able to clear up a lot of billing questions that she had with Jonathan, which should make invoicing smoother in the future. The general consensus seems to be to spend 2026 coming up with a solid plan and cost for Lake Morey West, and then start the project in 2027.
