- Had two separate meetings with Noel, Consolidated and All-Access concerning updating our phone systems. Ultimately we need to step away from outdated copper lines wherever possible, which are driving up our costs as they are becoming less compatible with existing technology. Once we get all the proposals and information sorted out and understood, it seems like there will be some considerable savings over our current copper system.
- I renewed our SAM registration so we can receive Federal awards for the year 2025
- All of the Water Operators' updates to the AMP documents have been submitted to Elizabeth Emmons at Dufresne. She is going to update the Plan with this information and the info she collected during her visits. She said that after the updating, this will generate a list of addresses that will need to be finalized for accuracy in the spring, which is when she'll bring the Operators into the process.
- Lynne Fitzhugh wants to hold a public meeting to talk about the formation of a conservation commission here at the auditorium on the evening of January 21<sup>st</sup>. She would like to know if the Selectboard wants to be involved in the meeting and to what extent.
