

TA Report 01/08/2024

- Movement is happening on the Alum treatment front! Peter, Tad and I have a meeting on Tuesday with Solitude to discuss upcoming steps and where we currently stand in the timeline. I have to send out a letter to all Lake Morey property abutters that alerts them to the proposed treatment, once the letters are sent our permitting process should be wrapped up.
- The building has been re-keyed as part of our ongoing security updates. I have extra keys available to assign to folks that may need them that I have overlooked.
- The front door latch has broken so it has been difficult to open properly, the same locksmith that rekeyed the building will be ordering a new replacement latch, no ETA as of yet
- The gate at the transfer station once again operational, I have reprogrammed the keypads and the remotes and will have to order a few more to cover all the parties that access the station on a regular basis. There is one more sensor that needs adjusting by Round Hill Fencing, but it is not integral to the gates operation.
- The 50% deposit has been put down on the kitchen flooring, waiting to hear back from Valley Floors as to what dates are available to do the project
